Report

The Freshmen Engineering Department under the innovation & incubation cell, Narayana Engineering College (Autonomous), Gudur has organized the National Science Day programme under the theme of “Integrated Approach in Science and Technology for Sustainable Future” on 28-02-2022 at CSE Seminar Hall. As a part of curriculum of college, celebrating National Science Day on 28th Feb every year, it has been conducted in our college. Dr. V. Raviprasad, Principal, Narayana Engineering College was the chairperson and Mrs. Y. Neeraja, Head of the Freshmen Engineering Department was the Convener of this programme

Mrs. Y. Neeraja, Convener of this programme has addressed on this occasion that National Science Day is celebrated every year on February 28. This day recalls the notable invention “Raman Effect” by India’s greatest scientist Sir C. V. Ramam. He was awarded the Nobel Prize for this discovery. Since that day, February 28 is being commemorated as National Science Day to recall the great discovery of Sir C. V. Raman.

On the occasion, Dr. V. Raviprasad, Chairperson of this programme has addressed to the students that in 1986, National Council for Science and Technology Communication (NCSTC) asked the Government of India to designate February 28 as National Science Day. The event is now celebrated all over the country in schools, colleges, universities and other academic, scientific, technical, medical and research institutions. On the occasion of the first National Science Day held on 28 February 1987, NCSTC announced institution of the National Science Popularization awards for recognizing outstanding efforts in the area of science communication and popularization. In addition to that, he has delivered the speech about the role of science in our daily life through Engineering and Technology with few examples and concluded his speech with moral statement “There is no development in Engineering and Technology without Science”.

In order to celebrate the programme in effective way, Essay writing contest, Poster presentation, Project/Working model demonstration and Science Quiz competitions have been conducted. The students were greatly encouraged to participate under the guidance of the Faculty members and eagerly participated in the above mentioned competitions. The registration fee of Rs. 20/- has been collected from the registered students to distribute the prizes and certificates. The total amount of Rs. 6600/- received from 330 students.

For Essay writing contest, 119 students were registered. Three essays have been selected for prize distribution. For poster presentation, 21 groups with 55 students were registered. Three groups have been selected for prize distribution. For Project/Working Model demonstration, 6 groups with 11 students were registered. Three groups have been selected for prize distribution. For Science Quiz, 29 groups with 145 students were registered. Two groups have been selected for prize distribution.

At the end of this programme, the prizes and certificates were distributed to the winners of each competition by Dr. V. Ravi Prasad, Principal, Mr. Vishwaksena Reddy, Vice Principal and Mrs. Y. Neeraja, HoD of FED.
