### *Orientation Programme on Academic Projects*

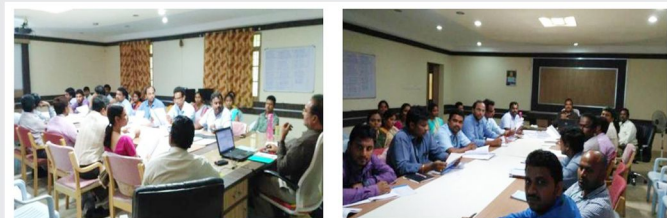
